Wrong Views of God's Law

- Legalism: Adding laws where God does not
- Antinomianism: rejecting God's moral law

Proper Views of God's Law

- Moral Law: Unchanging laws based on God's character
- Ceremonial Law: Laws given to Israel to govern their worship.
- Civil Law: Laws given to govern National Israel addressing justice, order, and societal matters

Three-fold use of God's Law

- Restrain Evil: Civil use
- Mirror: Theological use
- Guide: Didactic use
